How to Enroll in WebAssign for Your Class

Before you begin, make sure you have the **Class Key** given to you by your instructor.

- 1. Go to webassign.net and click on Enter Class Key
- 2. Enter the class key provided by your instructor and click on **Enroll**
- 3. Verify that you have the correct course and instructor and click Continue
- 4. On the sign-in page, enter your UVM email address. For most people the email address that works will be your UVM email address in the form **netid@uvm.edu** (replacing "netid" with your own netid), not the first.last@uvm.edu format. You should already have a Cengage/WebAssign password from a previous math class and/or the Math Readiness Test.

If you don't know your password, click on **Need Help Signing In**, then **Forgot Password**, and enter your email address in the netid@uvm.edu format. After completing the password reset, go back to step 1 and start over.

If the system doesn't recognize your email address at all, as a last resort you can create a new account.

- 5. When you log in, it should take you straight to your list of courses if your access has carried over from a previous semester.
 - If you have not yet paid for access, you will land on a Welcome page indicating that payment is required. You will have an option to enter an access code (if you purchased one from the Bookstore) or click on **Continue**. On the next page you will see options to purchase access. If you are not ready to purchase, click on **Temporary Access.** You can use the Temporary Access at the beginning of the semester until you are ready to purchase access.
- 6. When You Are Ready to Purchase Access: You can either purchase an access code the Bookstore or purchase access from within WebAssign. Access codes purchased at the Bookstore are for the Homework and eBook Multi-Term, which is valid for all three semesters of calculus. If you purchase from within WebAssign, there is a choice of Homework and eBook Single-Term, Homework and eBook Multi-Term, and Cengage Unlimited. If you are in MATH 021 or 022 or 023 and will be continuing on to the next course in the sequence (MATH 022 or MATH 121), you should either select Homework and eBook Multi-Term Access (use the dropdown to select Multi-Term), or purchase Cengage Unlimited. If you are in MATH 121 the Single-Term access will be your cheapest option.
